



CRUNCH TIME – “Wizard of OZ has spoken” -- a united “JOIN, or FREY” coalition could emerge... but courage-challenged major candidates unlikely to lead –

Minneapolis, MN, 10/13/2021 – Last week Mayoral candidates **Jerrell Perry** and **Bob “Again” Carney Jr.** (“bobagain”) were among four people who showed up at “People’s Plaza” (across from City Hall) on Oct. 7th to mark the tenth anniversary of the Minneapolis Occupy movement, documented by a [video](#). But “the Wizard of OZ has spoken,” opined Candidate/Journalist bobagain – “the Star Tribune Editorial Board (“EB”) aligned with the ‘OZ consensus’ with their strong endorsement of incumbent Mayor Jacob Frey. Only three candidates survived the “Official Land of OZ Money + Media Primary”: question #2 opponent Mayor **Frey**, and question #2 supporters **Sheila Nezhad** and **Kate Knuth**. Three other candidates were mentioned only by name: **A.J. Awed**, **Clint Conner** and **Mark Globus** – all are question #2 opponents (**Perry** supports question #2, bobagain opposes #2.)

“It’s CRUNCH TIME,” bobagain said. “My phoning around has led me to conclude at least some of the ‘major candidates’ may be ‘courage-challenged’ -- skittish-to-scarred to, as a group, actively and openly organize support for any ‘[JOIN, or FREY](#)’ Ranked Choice Vote (“RCV”) ticket -- or group of tickets – that is calculated to prevent Mayor Frey’s re-election. On a De Facto basis, almost all appear to support or accept his re-election as a given. We’ll hold the next public ‘Peaceable Assembly’ at People’s Plaza this Thursday, Oct 14th, at 3 PM. It’s a ‘make-or-break’ event for the Mayoral election’s outcome in this sense: A group of candidates and voters could emerge supporting one or more RCV tickets calculated to replace Mayor **Frey**, who is also invited. I’m calling on all Mayoral candidates to promise to resign in one year or two years to give voters a kind of ‘warranty’ – If they don’t like what they’re seeing, they can respond by electing a new Mayor,” bobagain said, and concluded: “I’m not in charge of this event, going forward to November I plan to focus on my role as a journalist.”

In the aftermath of multiple recent shootings in the Twin Cities, law enforcement is encouraged to monitor the event.
