Minneapolis, May 18, 2020 – “Openly Sane” GOP US Senate candidate Bob “Again” Carney Jr. has suspended his campaign. He is attempting to recruit someone else to challenge the Trump takeover of the Minnesota GOP – which he believes has transformed the “party of ideas” into a vacuous personality cult.

If no one else comes forward, “I’ll do something”, bobagain said. That “something” could be filing in the primary, then re-suspending the campaign and touring the state to explore whether an actual, active campaign should be launched sometime in July. “Minnesota’s legacy of divided government – 28 out of the last 30 years – is endangered by the Trump disaster – total DFL control in 2021 could be disastrous. Politically evicted but openly sane Republicans need to stand up and meet this challenge,” bobagain said.

Meanwhile, as an elected Delegate to the recently postponed State Convention, bobagain downloaded the 2020 platform committee’s report, and reviewed it while the convention’s organizers were dealing with an apparent hack-attack. “I’ll be commenting on this separately sometime soon,” bobagain said.
