

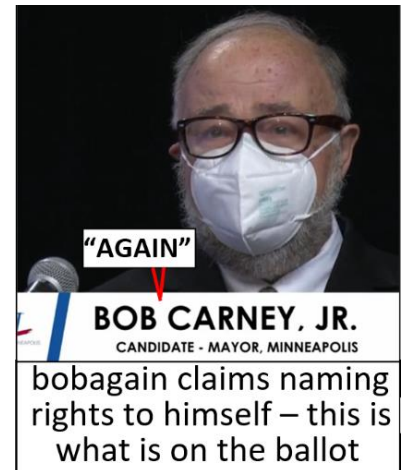

Minneapolis, MN, 9/30/2021 – On October 7th 2011 Minnesotans began assembling daily at the Hennepin County Government Center North Plaza – which came to be called “People’s Plaza” – as part of the larger Occupy Wall Street movement. The assembly continued on a 24-hour basis for weeks; as Winter arrived the Hennepin County Board provided a large tent on the South plaza. Recently, Republican candidate for Mayor, self-described “candidate-journalist” and “School Bus expert” (his driving is suspended until Feb 2022 and his work role has shifted to driver recruiting) Bob “Again” Carney Jr., (bobagain) has declared the plaza at a [“Peaceable Assembly Zone”](#) for “politically homeless” people – especially former Republicans.

“I participated extensively in the 2011 Minneapolis Occupy event, which I thought was very useful and educational, bobagain said. Part of bobagain’s participation was by providing teach-ins – one example is still on youtube: as [Economic Meltdown I](#) and [Economic Meltdown II](#). “With the Minneapolis municipal elections approaching – and no shortage of serious issues on the ballot – it seems this would be a good time to renew the kind of public participation and dialogue that the Occupy movement represented,” bobagain said.

“I’m inviting everyone to come to the Hennepin Government Center North Plaza, AKA ‘People’s Plaza,’ on October 7th, bobagain said. “We should do this more frequently than once every decade. But hold it – there aren’t any porta-potties this time – yet...” he concluded.
